

Instructional Guide:
Mineral Feeder





### INITIAL SET-UP

when you first receive your mineral feeder, it will be strapped down on a pallet. The first step is to extend all four legs, insert the bolt through the holes at the end of the leg and tighten down the nuts.



INTERNALS

On the inside of your mineral feeder, you will find two pumps, an electrical box with an on and off switch, and a battery. The first pump is for spraying. The second pump will run for 15 seconds every 30 minutes to ensure your insecticide is thoroughly mixed.

## SIDE PANELS

Your mineral feeder will come with two side panels attached to it. These panels help keep your cows in the center of the feeder to maximize spraying!

### SPRAY NOZZLES

Your mineral feeder will come with 3 nozzles and a face rub. The top two nozzles are a band for a wide spray and an orifice nozzle for a straight stream. The bottom nozzle is a band spray nozzle. The face rub receives insecticide from the tube to help eliminate face flies.



## SOLAR POWER AND TRANSPORTATION

The mineral feeder comes with a solar panel to help keep your battery always charged up. The mineral feeder also comes with a chain that connects from one side to the other for easy transportation with a front-end loader.



# FILLING UP YOUR MINERAL FEEDER

When you are ready to pour your mineral or feed in, all you need to do is go around the back of the unit and pull down on the hatch, and you can pour your feed right in.



# ATTACHING YOUR METAL MAT

When you first get your mineral feeder, the metal mat will be inside of the unit. Take the metal mat out and attach it to the front two legs with the chains provided. This metal mat ensures that even if cows try to knock over the mineral feeder, they will be standing on their own weight and be impossible to do so.



FEEDER IN ACTION

When your cows come to feed, they will push open the door, and the feeder will start spraying insecticide automatically. You can adjust your top nozzle to spray higher or lower on your cows, depending on what you like.
